

The Integra System Components form the central framework of the Integra Energy Management System and are provided with each Integra software license. Configuring these components to match your organizations unique requirements reflects the scalability of Integra's application and database architecture.

## **Database Manager**

The Database Manager provides common master file data sharing, maintenance, inquiry and reporting. Sharing of common organization data for Chart of Accounts, Property and Well Master data and Business Entity Name and Address data are enabled by the Database Manager component.

## **Database Explorer**

The Database Explorer provides a data driven drill-down interface for all master file and historical data retained by the system. By identifying key system data elements such as a vendor name, Integra's Database Explorer can drill down to any of that vendor's data in the system and provide inquiry and security controlled update to that information.

## **Database Engine**

Integra's Database Engine architecture incorporates scaleable relational database engine technology with support for both workgroup and client server database engines. Integra Database Engines provide imbedded self-tuning database technology that provide low maintenance database alternatives. Integra's optional server based support provides scalability to hundreds of users and processing for thousands of properties. Support for ODBC drivers and Microsoft Office Products and 3<sup>rd</sup> Party Reporting tools allow access to your data as needed.

## **License Manager**

The embedded License Manager controls concurrent user and application access support within Integra. This component simplifies software version and update distribution with per workstation configuration requirements.

## **Session Manager**

The Session Manager is an integral component of the Integra user interface environment. Integra's windows standard multiple document interface incorporates integrated multi-threading. These features allow any system user to run multiple entry or inquiry screens simultaneously while managing multiple active background sessions.

## **Security Manager**

The Security Manager controls user login permissions and roles on a corporate entity, application and system function basis. System users have authorized access by user or by group to only the data and system processes that they need while protecting corporate information.

## **Company Manager**

The Company Manager organizes information for each corporate entity whose data is processed by Integra. System configuration and processing options are maintained on a corporate entity or inter-company basis and control various processing and system behaviors
